Moon Base Explorers Program Info



Welcome to the Moon Base Explorers Program! This hands-on, immersive STEM experience gives your students early exposure to multiple science standards, as well as a chance to work cooperatively to explore space in a fun and exciting new way.

The Moon Base Explorer Program lasts 2 hours. Your students will spend time in both our Apollo Early Learners Room and in our Planetarium. To make this an educational and enjoyable experience for all, here are a few things that MUST be done for your mission:

- Fill out the Moon Base Explorers Crew Manifest and have it ready when you arrive.
- Bring 5 adult chaperones PER CLASS (typically 1 GROUP OF 25 STUDENTS), not including the
 teacher(s), to act as the Mission Specialists. The success of the mission relies heavily on the Mission
 Specialists' guidance through tasks and activities.
 - Any group larger than 30 students requires the booking of a second program.
- Share the Mission Specialist Information Sheet with your chaperones.
- Arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled Moon Base Explorers program time.
- Plan to have your students use the restroom before your scheduled start time. There will be a
 restroom break halfway through the program, but that is after 1 hour of activities.
- Please refrain from cell phone usage and text messaging during the program, as the students require
 assistance throughout the whole program.
