

Your Teacher is a Mind Reader

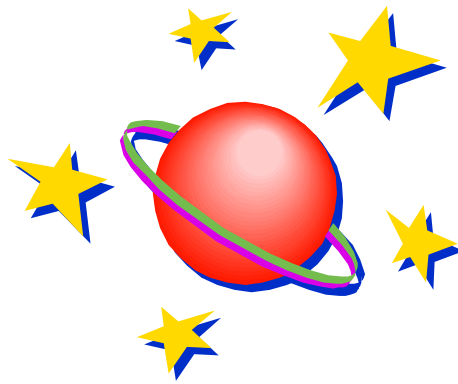


Teachers Information:

When the students are on their mission, they must follow directions without skipping ahead. This is an exercise in following directions. If the student follows all the directions, there are only a few answers.

You may wish to do this orally. Read the questions, then have the students write in their answers. After all questions are read, you can finish dramatically by "reading their minds!"

The most common answer to question #13 is a [gray elephant from Denmark](#). (You may have students who opt for the Dominican Republic instead of Denmark. Note that if students pick Dominican Republic the animal they choose will also be different.)

If the number is >5 , subtract 4 _____
7. Multiply by 2 _____
8. Subtract 6 _____
9. Map the digit to the alphabet (A=1, B=2, C=3, etc...) _____
10. Pick a country that begins with that letter _____
11. Use the second letter in the name of that country
and think of an animal that begins with that letter. _____
12. Think of the color of that animal _____
