Welcome to the Moonbase Explorers Program! This hands-on STEM experience gives your students exposure to multiple science standards, as well as a chance to work cooperatively to explore science in a fun way.

The Moonbase Explorer Program lasts 2 hours. Your students will spend time in both our Apollo Moonbase Room and in our Planetarium. To make this an educational and enjoyable experience for all, plan to do the following:

- Bring 5 adult chaperones PER GROUP of 24 students (class), not including the teacher(s), to act as the Mission Specialists. The success of the mission relies heavily on the Mission Specialists' guidance.
  - If your class is larger than 24 students, please bring 1 more adult chaperone than the required
    Any group larger than 30 students requires the booking of a second program.
- Fill out the Moonbase Explorers Crew Manifest and have it ready when you arrive.
- Share the Mission Specialist information Sheet with your volunteers.
- Please arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled Moonbase Explorers program time.
- Plan to have your students use the restroom before your scheduled start time. There will also be a restroom break halfway through the program as well.
- Please refrain from cell phone usage and text messaging during the program, as the students require assistance throughout the whole program.
